

## **POLICY 547 – COMMUNICABLE DISEASES**

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- I. Students with communicable diseases will not be excluded from attending school in their regular classrooms as long as their attendance does not constitute a health threat to other students or employees of the District. The District will attempt to keep interruptions to learning resulting from communicable diseases to a minimum while following recommendations from Hennepin County Community Health Department and private health care providers. Procedures for the inclusion of students with communicable diseases will include review of the educational implications for the student and safety of others with whom he or she comes into contact.
  
- II. Students enrolled in District schools must provide proof of immunization or exemption to attend School (M.S. 121A.15).
